## Tacoma Public Library 2017 Little Kids' Summer Learning Adventure For kids birth – Pre-Kindergarten

### Rules & Directions

**Complete 1 bingo a week for a possible total of 5 bingos.**

- The first day to join and pick up a log is Thursday, June 1<sup>st</sup>
- The last day to turn in your log is Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup>

\* **There is no online reporting this year.**

### How to play:

1. Pick up a log sheet from your local branch. One log per child.
2. Complete a square by doing the early literacy activity listed.
3. Complete 5 squares to make a bingo. Bingos may be made by going straight across, up and down, or diagonally.
4. When you have a bingo, come to the library to have your log stamped and turn in the attached drawing slip.
5. For every bingo you complete, your child will be entered into a weekly drawing for prizes; tickets to the Washington State Fair, passes to NW Trek, and tickets to see the Tacoma Rainiers play.

**When you have completed your first bingo, come to the library to collect your prize. You will earn:**

- Coupons/certificates from local businesses
- A paperback book or a board book
- 2 tickets to the Summer Reading Celebration at Point Defiance Zoo & Aquarium on Saturday, August 5<sup>th</sup>

*The last day to pick up prizes is Saturday, August 5<sup>th</sup> while supplies last.*

Make up a story using puppets or stuffed animals	Read a story together	Sing to your child (your favorite songs as well as theirs)	Come to the library and let your child choose a book	Build with blocks
Print your child's name in big letters and help them trace the letters with their finger	Take a picture of your child "reading" then look at it with them and talk about it	Read a story together	Learn and say a fingerplay with your child	Use shaving cream as finger paint to draw and make letters on a table
Listen to children's music in the car while running errands	Play dress-up	<b>FREE</b>	Read a story together	Play with play-dough
Read a story together	Make a book about things your child does every day and read the book aloud	Attend a library program	Create a spot in your home for a box or basket of books your child can easily access	Use a ruler or spoon and tap on objects to explore sound
Ask your child silly questions to which the answer is "no" – (Does the cat drive the car?)	Play a version of "Simon Says" (Simon says jump)	Borrow a CD of lullabies from the library	Count the items your little one is paying attention to; blocks, flowers, puzzle pieces, etc.	Read a story together
