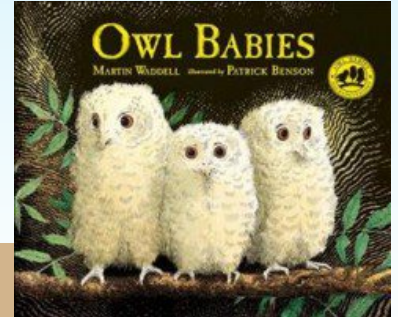

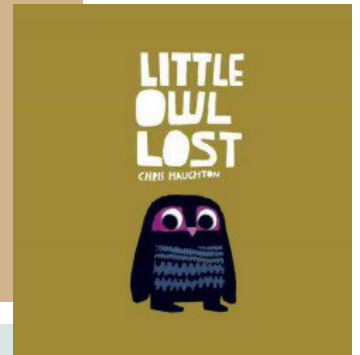
Five Hoot Owls

 And says, "Whoop! Whoop!" (say "whoop")

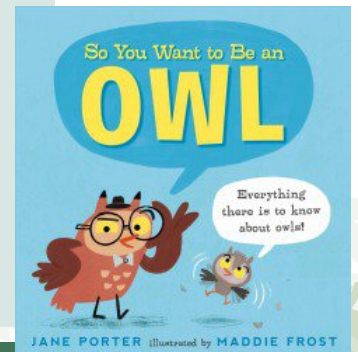


Owl Hokey Pokey
