



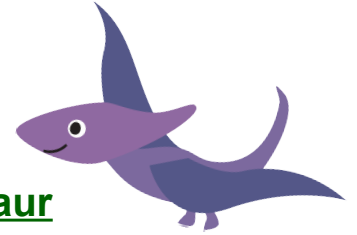

Dino Paper Plate Craft

- Paper plate
- Toilet paper roll
- Construction paper
- Markers
- Glue
- Scissors
- Optional: stickers, pom-poms, etc.

1. Cut the paper plate in half
2. Cut two slits about an inch deep into the toilet paper rolls
3. Slide paper plate into slits
4. Using construction paper cut out a dinosaur head and tail
5. Glue on head and tail
6. Draw eyes/face on head
7. Have your child decorate the dinosaur.



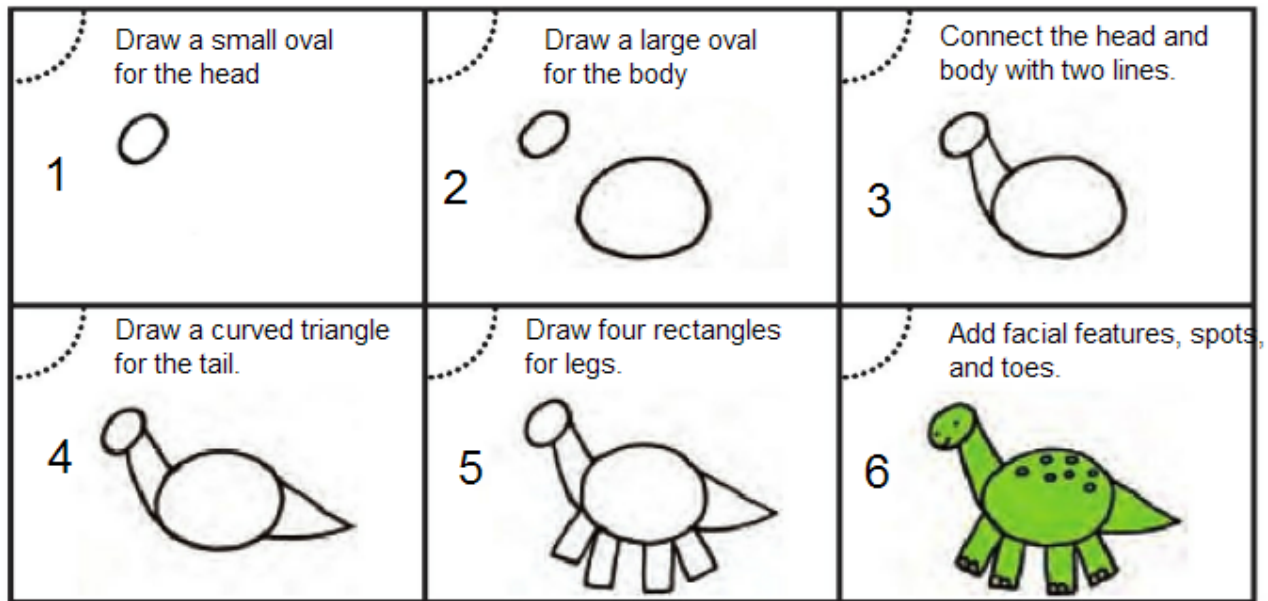
