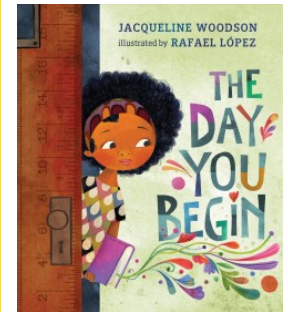
Once every circle is filled, stop in the library for your reward!

EARLY LITERACY TIP:

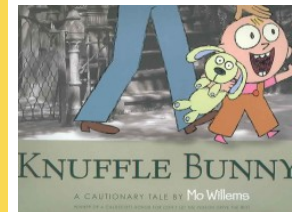

HOW IT WORKS

Children who have not yet started kindergarten are eligible to participate in the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program.

- 1** | Sign up today! Online at Tacomalibrary.beanstack.org
- 2** | Enter your books online to track your child's progress.
- 3** | After each 100 book milestone, visit the library to receive your reward.
- 4** | When your child reaches 1,000 books read, stop into the library and get a certificate and a reward!

FAQs

How do we read 1,000 books by kindergarten?

It's easy!

1 book per day for 3 years = 1,095

10 books per week for 2 years = 1,040

3 books a day for 1 year = 1,095

Do we have to read only books from the library?

Nope, any age appropriate books count! No matter where you get them or how many times you read them – they all count!

I have more than one child I read to. Can I count the same title for each child?

Of course!
