### How does it work?

TPS students are automatically enrolled in the Pathway Program. Using their student ID number, students can:

#### Check out up to 5 items

- To check out, visit a library and present your student ID card or tell staff your ID#

#### Hold/Reserve up to 5 items

- Provide email or phone to receive hold pickup notices
